

## Program Adaptations For the A-Z Word Game



### Adaptations

Here are a few ways in which this program can be adapted for many different Participants

#### Individuals

- Make copies of the A-Z Game for the Week but cover up the Answer Column AND the Clues Column before making copies and passing them out OR Make copies but cover up ONLY the Answer column before making copies. Having clues will make this a bit easier
- Make pencils handy
- Challenge Participants to work on the page as they wait for other activities (such as physical therapy)
- Open up the game for additional answers for each letter, (beyond the clues)
- See who can get the most right in a certain amount of hours or days
- Announce and post winners

#### Groups

- Use a big write-on-wipe-off board or paper flip chart for the alphabet and the answers
- Work on the list cooperatively
- Ask participants if they can create a poem with some of the words

#### Non-verbal participants

- Make a set of alphabet index cards A-Z.
- Fan the cards out in front of the least involved participants
- Challenge your group to think of additional words for that letter
